

## Our Players

The Legends of Baseball Tournaments are an opportunity for "Men of Good Cheer" to come together and participate in the grand old game of baseball. In order to accomplish this goal, we use modified baseball rules such as no stealing, no passed balls, unlimited substitution and a rolling batting order to allow more players the opportunity to participate and enjoy the game. Only players 65 and older may use metal bats.

Our players range in age from 18 to 93. While our camps are for men and women over 30, we welcome the participation of other family members over the age of 18 to join their fathers, uncles and in some cases, their grandfathers, to enjoy the game they love on the field "where it all began..."

A reception is held after the first day of games, which allows the members of each team time to get to know one another off the field. The Awards banquet is held Wednesday night where all the teams and players are introduced. The highlight of the evening is a 20 minute slide show of some of the fantastic and not so fantastic plays of the week. All players receive a memorable souvenir of the great week of baseball.

The Awards Banquet closes with the announcement of the playoff schedule for the last day. This is a casual affair and guests are welcome.

## Who Can Participate?

- ⊗ Singles and smaller groups welcome.
- ⊗ Players (age 18 - 30) who are relatives of over 30 players may participate. Sorry, no one under 30 may pitch.



- ⊗ Up to eight players may play as a group (not more than three can pitch).
- ⊗ Player draft will be held two weeks prior to the camp.

Every effort will be made to distribute players by age and talent, so that the competition will be as even as possible.
